Two Rivers Water Reclamation Authority, Monmouth County

Dear Mr. Gianforte:

This is in reference to your letter dated June 18, 2008 requesting the rescission of the existing sewer connection ban imposed on the Two Rivers Water Reclamation Authority's (Authority) collection system. The Authority serves the municipalities of Fair Haven, Little Silver, Monmouth Beach, Oceanport, Shrewsbury, West Long Branch, Eatontown, Fort Monmouth, Red Bank, Rumson, Sea Bright, Shrewsbury Township and Tinton Falls. This office has reviewed the request and the certification that the Authority's sanitary sewer system has "adequate conveyance capacity" as per N.J.A.C. 7:14A-1.9. Therefore, the sewer connection ban on the Authority is hereby rescinded.

However, should the Authority's collection system, at any time, fail to meet the requirement of adequate conveyance capacity or its treatment plant is out of compliance with its NJPDES Permit in accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:14A-22.17, the Authority must reinstate a sewer connection ban, in compliance with N.J.A.C. 7:14A-22.1 et seq.
