

Monmouth Beach and Member/Customer Towns

The Two Rivers Water Reclamation Authority (TRWRA) is working in conjunction with Hazen and Sawyer and Schiavone Construction Co. LLC (Schiavone) to replace TRWRA's aging Pleasure Bay Interceptor and Main Pump Station in Monmouth Beach.

We are anticipating the following schedule for the work through September:

- Currently underway – Schiavone is currently excavating and supporting the shaft with shotcrete.
- Throughout September 2024 – Schiavone will continue excavating the shaft down to the proposed invert for the tunnel. Schiavone will also continue to truck excavated shaft material out of the plant. Tunnel boring operations are expected to start in the mid portion of September.

Impacts will occur during working hours as the Contractor is continuing the excavation activities in September. As the excavation continues, minor roadway impacts will occur due to the trucking away of excavated materials and the delivery of concrete via concrete mixer trucks. Any impacts to the local traffic patterns will be coordinated with

the local police department and authorities to ensure the safe maintenance of traffic in the affected areas.

The Contractor may be working night shifts on weekdays during the month of September, but work will be contained to the Monmouth Beach jobsite and will not involve the trucking away of excavated materials and therefore will not impact the local roadways.

We will continue to provide monthly updates throughout the project and any upcoming impacts that may be anticipated to the local communities.
