Notice is hereby given that sealed bids will be received by the Two Rivers Water Reclamation Authority (hereinafter referred to as the Authority) at the Authority's office, 1 Highland Avenue, Monmouth Beach, New Jersey on **Wednesday, August 27, 2025**, at **10:30 AM**, prevailing time, for furnishing and delivery of twenty-four (24) month supply of Bioxide 71 or equal for the removal of hydrogen sulfide and other common odors in wastewater collection and treatment plant, commencing on **NOVEMBER 1, 2025 through OCTOBER 31, 2027**, in accordance with specifications which are on file in the offices of the Authority at the above address, and may be examined at that address, during regular business hours, 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., prevailing time Monday through Friday. **The Bid Documents are FREE and available for download, by the bidder at www.TRWRA.org.**

Bids must be received by the Authority not later than 10:30 AM, prevailing time, Wednesday, August 27, 2023, at said Authority's offices at which time all bids will be opened and read, or as soon thereafter as the matter may be reached.

Bids must be enclosed in a sealed envelope bearing the name and address of the bidder, and the name of the proposed work on the outside. It shall be addressed to the Executive Director of the Authority at the above address, and marked clearly on the outside lower left hand corner "Sealed Bid—Bioxide 71 or Equal". The bid shall clearly set forth the proposed price for the twenty-four (24) months' supply of Bioxide 71 or Equal.

The bid must be accompanied by a certified check, cashier's check or bid bond payable to the Authority as a guarantee that if the Contract is awarded to the bidder, that the bidder will enter into a Contract. The amount to be deposited shall be ten percent (10%) of the base bid but shall not, in any case, exceed \$20,000.00.

Bids must be made on the standard proposal form in the manner designated therein and required by the specifications.

Bidders are required to comply with the requirements of N.J.S.A. 10:5-31 et. seq. and N.J. A.C 17:27 (Affirmative Action); and P.L. 1963, C. 150; (Prevailing Wage); and Americans With Disabilities Act.
