Mr. MacStudy asked Mr. Rodriguez if there was an update on the audit. Mr. Rodriguez replied that he received the updated list of open items and is working on a couple items for the single audit.

Mr. Galvin said that there was a resolution that was not yet finalized at the time the package was sent out for the Pump Station 18 Efficiency Project and was to be handed out at the meeting.

Mr. Galvin explained that Resolution 2025-06-72 aims to eliminate Pump Station 18, located near the end of Riverside Avenue, off Oceanport Avenue. This facility, often referred to as a "small can," is mostly underground, with only a control panel above ground. As part of the Pump Station 14 Project, a stub for future connection had been provided on Riverside Avenue. A connection will be made to this stub, which will allow for the elimination of Pump Station 18. Additionally, Ms. Lechner will finalize the design for the removal of the Horseneck Point Pump Station, which is currently under review by the Army. The elimination of 4 pump stations will be completed as part of the Efficiency Project.

Mr. Berdahl wanted to know why the Authority was still in communication with the Army, when he thought it should be FMERA. Mr. Galvin explained that the Authority is still reviewing certain sections of the 400 area, which are designated carve-outs under the Army's jurisdiction. Within these sections, there are environmentally sensitive areas containing contaminated soil that require evaluation.
